RAINBOW ROOM
A PROMISE OF HOPE
& A HEART FOR CHILDREN

“The Rainbow Room of Hood & Somervell Counties is a nonprofit organization dedicated to restoring dignity and hope to abused and neglected children under the care of Child Protective Services.”

THE RAINBOW ROOM (RR) is an emergency resource center in a store-like setting that distributes new items to Child Protective Services (CPS) caseworkers for their clients and foster children. It provides items such as clothing, school supplies, personal hygiene items, infant items, car seats, cribs/beds, bedding, toys, cleaning supplies and much more. These items are available at the CPS office 7 days a week 24 hours a day. Children who are removed from abusive situations can go into foster or kinship care with the dignity of having new possessions they can call their own. Each child upon removal is given a new tote bag with 3 outfits, pajamas, underwear, toys, and hygiene items. Assistance can also be given to families who are not found to be abusive but are needing help.



The Rainbow Room serves an average of 50 clients per month. With help from United Way of Hood County; the generous people of Hood and Somervell counties and countless volunteer hours, the RR helps children impacted by abuse and neglect in a variety of ways.

FAMILY REUNIFICATION BASKETS – A gift basket is presented to each family when children are reunited with their parents after being in foster care. The baskets include personal hygiene items, cleaning and household items, toys, and family games.



FOSTER CHILD SPONSORSHIPS – We offer \$500 enrichment activity scholarships to foster children each year. These include opportunities through-out the year, i.e. summer camp, sports camp, piano lessons, gymnastics, dance class, cheerleading.

HOST AGING-OUT PARTIES – When a child reaches the age of 18 they “age-out” of foster care. Along with donations from Kash-For-Kids and other organizations, the RR and volunteers host a “shower” with items needed as he/she becomes a young adult; maybe moving into a first apartment or going off to college.



MORAL SUPPORT FOR CPS STAFF – In appreciation for the hard work and dedication of the CPS staff, the RR coordinates monthly meals and treats through the Caring-For-Caseworkers Program. Rainbow Room Board members and volunteers also provide special events throughout the year. In April, Child Abuse Prevention Month, as a special treat to the CPS staff the RR provides a masseuse for chair massages. The RR volunteers also decorate the break room in seasonal and holiday decor to provide a touch of love and support for our caseworkers who deal with so many hard and sad situations every day.



In APRIL, the RR supports National CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH by providing blue ribbons to decorate Hood and Somervell Counties and participates in other community activities to raise awareness of child abuse.
